

Mr. Scott M. McCain is the Midwest Emergency Preparedness Manager in the Operations Support Department at Exelon Nuclear.

Exelon Nuclear is headquartered in Warrenville, Ill., and is a business unit of Exelon Corporation. It operates the largest nuclear fleet in the nation and the third largest fleet in the world. Exelon's ten stations – with 17 reactors – represent approximately 20 percent of the U.S. nuclear industry's power capacity.

Mr. McCain graduated cum laude from Excelsior College with a B.S. degree in Nuclear Technologies. He is currently the lead task force member for the NEI EP Threat Based Drill Program initiative.
