Mr. Plisco has worked for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission since 1982. He has held positions of increasing responsibility including roles as a reactor inspector, reactor construction inspector, a senior resident inspector at a commercial reactor plant, inspection program staff, supervisor, manager, and a leader for numerous special projects and initiatives. He has worked in the Region I Office, King of Prussia, PA; the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation and the Office of the Executive Director for Operations, Rockville, MD; and Region II, Atlanta, GA. He was appointed to the Senior Executive Service in 1997. In 2003 he was selected to be the Deputy Regional Administrator for Region II, and most recently in 2006, he was selected to be the Deputy Regional Administrator for Construction. In this position, he is responsible for regulatory oversight of construction activities at commercial nuclear reactors and fuel cycle facilities nationwide.

Prior to joining the NRC, Mr. Plisco served for five years on active duty as a submarine officer in the U.S. Navy's Nuclear Power Program. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Systems Engineering from the U.S. Naval Academy and a Master's Degree in Technical Management from Johns Hopkins University. In 2002, he received the Presidential Meritorious Rank Award.
