## INCIDENT RESPONSE EXPERIENCE

Attendees are invited to experience the inner workings of the NRC Operations Center which serves as the focal coordination point for communicating with NRC licensees, State entities, and other Federal agencies regarding operating events in both the nuclear reactor and materials industry.
