

Mr. Brian D. McFeaters is the Assistant Director, Wake County Emergency Management Agency, Wake County, North Carolina.

Wake County Emergency Management Agency is a division of the Wake County Public Safety Department. Wake County is the location of the State Capital and has 11 municipalities within the county. Population of Wake County is currently about 810,000 and rapidly growing.

Mr. McFeaters graduated from The Pennsylvania State University with a B.S. degree in Meteorology. He has lived in North Carolina since the mid 1970's.

Mr. McFeaters has been Assistant Director, Wake County Emergency Management since 2000. He is responsible for the Emergency Preparedness Team which consists on a Hazardous Materials Specialist, Nuclear Emergency Planner and a Domestic Terrorism Planner. The team develops plans and standard operating procedures, conducts training for first responders, town leaders and county officials and maintains operational status of county emergency response assets.

From 1998 until 2000, Mr. McFeaters was the Nuclear Emergency Planner for Wake County Emergency Management. Mr. McFeaters worked for Carolina Power & Light Company as the Chief Meteorologist from 1976 – 1989, Corporate Emergency Planner from 1989 –1991 and Manager, Harris Nuclear Plant Emergency Preparedness 1991 – 1996.
