

## **Brian McCabe**

Brian began his career in 1982 as a licensed Reactor Operator at the University of Virginia's research reactor. In 1984, Brian became a System Engineer at Exelon's Dresden nuclear plant and in 1988, he earned a Senior Reactor Operator (SRO) License at Dresden. Brian served as Operations Shift Supervisor and then Control Room Supervisor from 1988 to 1991.

In 1991, he joined the Nuclear Regulatory Commission as an NRR Project Manager responsible for the licensing activities associated with the James A. FitzPatrick plant in New York. In 1994, he was named Senior Regional Coordinator and Technical Advisor for the NRC's Executive Director for Operations (EDO). He served three EDOs. In 1998, NRC Commissioner Jeffrey Merrifield selected Brian to be his Senior Technical Advisor for Reactors. In that role, he served as the Commissioner's advisor for regulatory, technical, and policy matters pertaining to the nuclear power industry. In 2002, Brian joined Progress Energy and has since served in various oversight and regulatory affairs positions. He is currently the Manager of Regulatory Affairs for Progress Energy's nuclear fleet.

Brian received a B.S. in Nuclear Engineering from the University of Virginia in 1984 and an MBA from Loyola in 1997.
