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# Standard Operating Procedure



- Supporting the Combined Licensing Application process for new reactors.
- Provide an understanding and guidance during the review process from the earliest letter or memo to the completion of the Interim Finding Report (IFR).
- Review 15 of the 16 NUREG-0654 Planning stds (109 criteria)



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# Application Site Situations

Operating Site	Non-Operating Site	
<b>Situation 1</b> A request to build a new reactor at an operating commercial NPP	<b>Situation 2</b> A request to build a new reactor at a non operating site within a State, or Tribal Nation that already has at least one operating commercial NPP.	<b>Situation 3</b> A request to build a new reactor in a State, or Tribal Nation with no operating commercial NPP.



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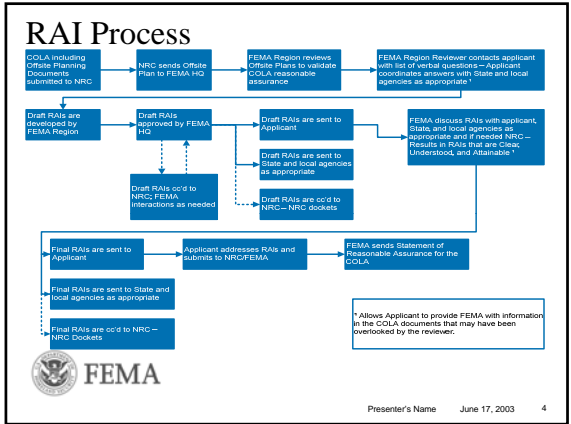
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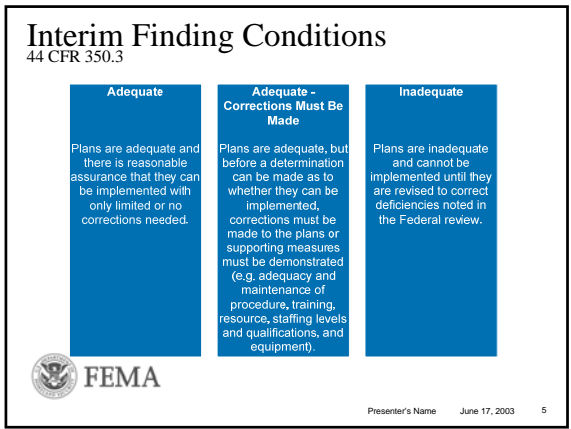
