Edward (Ted) Boling was named General Counsel of the Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) in January of 2008. Ted served came to CEQ as Deputy General Counsel in August of 2000 from the Environment and Natural Resources Division of the U.S. Department of Justice, where he was a senior trial attorney. Ted joined the Department of Justice in 1990 through the Attorney General's Honor Program. He served as a trial attorney until 1996, when he moved to the Department of the Interior. At the Department of the Interior, Ted was Counselor to the Assistant Secretary for Fish and Wildlife and Parks until his return to the Department of Justice in 1998.

He is a member of the American Bar Association's Section of Environment, Energy, and Resources, the Virginia State Bar, and has served on the Board of the Virginia State Bar Association's Environmental Law Section, which he chaired in 2000-01.

Ted graduated from Washington University School of Law in 1990, where he was Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Urban and Contemporary Law (now the Journal of Law & Policy) and represented his law school in national moot court competition. He received his B.A. in 1986 from Mary Washington College, where he majored in political science.
