

RAJENDER AULUCK

Dr. Auluck is the Chief, Engineering Review Branch 2 in the Division of License Renewal, office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation

Dr. Auluck joined the NRC in 1979 as a reactor systems engineer in the Office of Standards Development. He moved to NRR in 1980 as a licensing project manager and managed the review activities of several plants including WNP-2, which was licensed in 1984. From 1992 to 1999, Dr. Auluck was Section Chief in the Regulation Development Branch, RES, and in the Rulemaking Branch, NRR managing the rulemaking and other regulatory activities associated with the reactor and material licensees. He joined the Division of License Renewal in 2000 and has participated in several activities including managing the review of Turkey Point and V. C. Summer license renewal applications. Dr. has represented the NRC in several IAEA activities related to long term operation of nuclear power plants.

Prior to joining the NRC, Dr. Auluck was employed by Bechtel Power Corporation as a senior engineer. He has a Master of Science and a Ph. D in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Maryland. He is licensed professional engineer in the State of Maryland.
