

## **Richard Black**

Richard Black is the Director, Office of Advanced Reactor Concepts, Office of Nuclear Energy, U.S. Department of Energy. This office is responsible for nuclear power programs that involve the research, development, and demonstration of advanced reactor technologies, including small modular reactors, and high temperature gas and fast spectrum reactors. In DOE, Mr. Black formerly was the Associate Deputy Assistant Secretary, Office of Nuclear Energy; Director, Office of Nuclear and Facility Safety Policy; and the Director, Office of Nuclear Safety Enforcement. Prior to joining DOE, Mr. Black was an attorney with Tenera LLP, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, and the Internal Revenue Service. Mr. Black holds a BS from Michigan State University and a JD from Georgetown University.
