Ms. Bubar currently serves as the Director of the Environmental Protection and Performance Assessment Directorate in the Office of Federal, State, Materials and Environmental programs. Ms. Bubar joined the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in April, 2007 as the Deputy Director of the Division of Intergovernmental Liaison and rulemaking. In her current position, she oversees all environmental reviews under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) for uranium recovery applications and fuel enrichment facility license applications. Additionally, she is responsible for policy and communication with the states and the public on low level waste issues.

Prior to joining NRC, Ms. Bubar was at the Department of Energy in the Environmental Management Program and the Office of Health, Safety, and Security. In those programs, she was responsible for regulatory compliance for all environmental laws, nuclear materials transportation and nuclear safety oversight.

Prior to her years at the Department of Energy, she was at the Environmental Protection Agency in the Water, Superfund and Radiation programs.

Ms. Bubar graduated from the University of Pittsburgh with a degree in Civil Engineering with an emphasis on Environmental Engineering. She is a recipient of the Presidential Meritorious Rank Award as well as a Distinguished Career Service Award.
