

Charles Casto

Charles Casto is the Deputy Regional Administrator for Region IV, in Arlington, Texas. Prior to joining the NRC, he worked for seven years in the commercial nuclear power industry. He also served five years in the U.S. Air Force.

From 1978 to 1985, his career included working at Sequoyah Nuclear Plant in construction and operations. Later he worked as a licensed operator and Operations Instructor at Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant. Then at Brunswick Nuclear Plant he worked as an NRC-Certified Operations Instructor.

In 1992-1993, Charles served on a Congressional Fellowship as a Legislative Assistant to U.S. Senator Harry Reid. He also served on temporary assignments as a Technical Assistant to the Executive Director for Operations, as the Reactor Programs Assistant to NRC Chairman Selin.

For 23 years, Charles worked in various positions in the NRC's Region II Office in Atlanta.

Charles also serves in several appointed positions including as a Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award Examiner, former Chair of the Cobb County School District Blue Ribbon Committee on Education, and currently Chairman of the Cobb County School District (SPLOST) Facilities & Technology Committee.

He holds a B.S. degree from the State University of New York and a Masters in Public Administration from the University of Georgia.
