

James Curtiss

Jim Curtiss is a principal in Curtiss Law. From 1988 to 1993, he served as a Commissioner of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. Prior to that, he served for eight years as Counsel to the Subcommittee on Nuclear Regulation of the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee, where he was involved in the drafting of the Nuclear Waste Policy Act of 1982 and the amendment act of 1987, the Low Level Radioactive Waste Policy Amendments Act of 1985, and the Price Anderson reauthorization Act. From 1993 to 2008, he was a partner at Winston & Strawn, where he headed the Energy Group. He received a BA and JD from the University of Nebraska.
