Ms. Doane joined the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in 1991 as a Special Assistant (Legal) in the Office of the Secretary. She subsequently served as an attorney in the Office of Commission Appellate Adjudication from 1991 to 1998. During this time, she was responsible for drafting opinions on novel issues related to the NRC's licensing and regulatory responsibilities. She completed a rotational assignment as an Attorney in the Office of the General Counsel, Enforcement Branch in 1996. In 1998, Ms. Doane was appointed as Commissioner Jeffrey S. Merrifield's Legal Counsel. In 2002, she assumed the role as his Deputy Chief of Staff. In 2003, she became his Chief of Staff.

Prior to joining the NRC, Ms. Doane served for three years as an attorney advisor for the Department of Veterans Affairs, Board of Veterans Appeals. Ms. Doane received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from Loyola College in Baltimore and a Juris Doctorate from the University of Maryland, School of Law.
