

## **Kathy Halvey Gibson**

Kathy Halvey Gibson is the Deputy Director, Division of Systems Analysis, Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research, US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). Ms. Gibson joined the NRC in 1986 in Region I and served as a Resident and Senior Resident Inspector at the Salem and Hope Creek Nuclear Power Plants. Ms. Gibson was the NRC's first female Senior Resident Inspector. From 1990 to 1999, she served as a Reactor Technology Instructor, Section Chief, and Branch Chief at the Technical Training Center. From 2000 to 2004, she served as Chief, Emergency Preparedness and Health Physics Section, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. From 2004 - 2008, Ms. Gibson served as the Associate Director for Training and Development in the Office of Human Resources. Ms. Gibson came to the NRC from Duquesne Light Company, where she held progressively responsible chemistry positions at Shippingport Atomic Power Station, and quality assurance positions at Beaver Valley Power Station. Ms. Gibson received a B.S. degree in Chemistry from the Indiana University of Pennsylvania and completed graduate work in Nuclear Science and Engineering at Carnegie-Mellon University. She is a 2002 recipient of the NRC Meritorious Service Award and is an Indiana University of Pennsylvania Distinguished Alumna.
