

## **Donnie Harrison**

Donnie Harrison is the Chief of the Probabilistic Risk Assessment (PRA) Licensing Branch (APLA) in the Division of Risk Assessment. Mr. Harrison joined the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in 2000 as a Reliability and Risk Analyst within APLA and has worked on a number of activities involving the use of plant-specific PRAs in regulatory matters. Mr. Harrison has also served as the Chief of the Balance of Plant Branch and Safety Issue Resolution Branch in the Division of Safety Systems.

Prior to joining the NRC, Mr. Harrison was a consultant to the U.S. Department of Energy, commercial nuclear power plants, and nuclear industry groups, specializing in the development and use of PRA-related techniques for commercial and government nuclear facilities. While at the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, Mr. Harrison supported a number of NRC risk and regulatory programs.

Mr. Harrison earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Nuclear Engineering from the Missouri University of Science and Technology (previously known as the University of Missouri-Rolla) in 1983 and was a member of the NRC Leadership Potential Program Class of 2008.
