Dr. Jankovich has been with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for over 27 years. Currently he is team leader for the sealed source and device registration program. He is also the principal technical contact for the on-going initiatives regarding the security and use of cesium-137 chloride sources. He also serves as the NRC delegate to national and international standards. Previously, he was team leader for conducting safety inspections for transportation packages and spent fuel storage containers.
