

## **W15 Combined Licenses and Public Accessibility – Current Issues in the Adjudication of Applications for New Reactor Licenses**

In this session, a panel of experienced lawyers from industry, the public sector, State and local government, and the NRC will explore legal and regulatory challenges that have arisen in new reactor adjudicatory hearings. The session will focus particularly on cases and litigation involving combined license (COL) applications, including (1) their interface with ESPs and certified designs, (2) mandatory hearings, and (3) case management issues. In addition, the session will cover public accessibility and transparency issues, including issues related to mandatory disclosures, “sensitive unclassified non-safeguards information” (SUNSI), electronic filing, and the management and handling of privileged and protected information in otherwise public adjudicatory proceedings.
