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OE Reporting

- Nuclear plants report important plant events through an electronic system available to members.
- An event report includes information such as:
 - Event summary
 - Cause summary
 - Corrective actions
 - Attribute coding

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OE Reporting Cont.

- Attributes are identified in the following areas:
 - Event Types
 - Consequences
 - Component
 - Response
 - Cause
 - Corrective Action
 - Preventive Action

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OE Documents

- Various levels of documents exist based on the importance of the event and the need for the industry to take specific actions.
- Recommendations and/or lessons learned are included in the documents.
- Documents are sent electronically to members and posted on a Member Website.



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OE Videos

- Videos are developed for individual events, adverse event trends, and important industry topics.
- The videos often include interviews of station staff and those involved.
- Several videos have been filmed from within the plant.
- Videos are posted on a Member Website.



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
