Comprehensive Reviews

The offsite response capability at all operating commercial nuclear power plants was assessed as part of the DHS led Comprehensive Review program.

The Comprehensive Review process assessed local response capabilities to a hostile action at each plant.



Current Status of Integrated Response Planning

Utilizing a standard Integrated Response Plan template, all operating commercial nuclear power plants are actively participating with the FBI, Regional, State, and local response agencies in development of site specific Integrated Response Plans.



Integrated Response Planning Program Guidance

The Nuclear Energy Institute is working with the FBI and NRC to develop a robust Integrated Response Plan exercise program.

This new program will contribute to ensuring the Integrated Response Plans for nuclear power plants are periodically reviewed, exercised and updated.



Integrated Response Planning Program Guidance

The NEI Integrated Response Plan exercise program guidance will define the process for conduct of both a Table Top (TTX) and Limited Exercise (LX) of the Integrated Response Plan.



Integrated Response Planning Program Guidance

Conducting a TTX / LX of the IRP will provide tactical responders the following opportunities

- Conduct of mission planning for tactical operations within the nuclear plant confines,
- Understanding the impacts of the plant environment on tactical operations and communications protocols,
- Understanding and use of the applicable navigation / planning tools,
- Provide experience based input into the IRP Review and Update.
