- NRO and Region II staff conducted the Part 52 lessons learned self-assessment with input from internal and external stakeholders.
- The review was conducted as part of the NRC's routine program of self-assessment and continuous improvement.

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Part 52 Implementation Lessons Learned (continued)

- First year after the issuance of the first combined operating license (COL).
- Several findings (both good practices and areas for improvement) were identified.

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Part 52 Implementation Lessons Learned (continued)

Five Areas with Recommended Enhancements:

1. Design Control Document (DCD) Tier 2* information
2. Regulatory decision-making
3. Inspections, Tests, Analyses and Acceptance Criteria (ITAAC) closure
4. Vendor Inspection
5. Changes to the design basis during construction

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
