WG Purpose and Task

Conduct a holistic assessment of the fuel cycle licensing program to improve effectiveness and efficiency:

- Look for areas of transformation and innovation.
- Adhere to the NRC Principles of Good Regulation.
- Engage a broad range of stakeholders.
- · Collect and develop suggestions.
- Assess the licensing process and guidance.
- Consider processes and guidance from other divisions/offices.
- Evaluate suggestions.
- Develop WG report to Division management with conclusions and recommendations.



Summary to Date

Collected 32 Comments → 37 Suggestions

Three primary focus areas:

- Guidance and tool development
- Planning and processing
- Performance and documentation



Methods

- Suggestions from industry, WG members, and other NRC staff
- Letters, public meetings, and staff internal meetings and interactions
- Many interrelated suggestions
- Recommendations drafted to address individual suggestions
- Recommendation table included as an attachment to the WG report
- Use of a three-tier process to prioritize suggestions



Progress to Date

- · Completed draft report
 - Developed draft WG report
 - Held public teleconference to obtain feedback on draft
- Finalizing report for issuance
- Developing implementation recommendations
 - Multiple suggestions may be addressed by a coordinated action
- Identifying resource considerations



Example of Coordinated Action

- Numerous suggestions address the request for additional information (RAI) process:
 - Some are already NRC practices not in publicly available documentation
 - Some relate to improving aspects of the process
- Eight suggestions could be addressed by developing and making publicly available a business line instruction on the RAI process.
