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

Formal Knowledge Management Transfer Process

- Developed as Section of Guidance
- Jointly Developed by NRR and NMSS
 - Impacts due to Decommissioning New Business Models
 - License Transfer- front loading decommissioning submittals
 - Review resources
 - More coordination necessary between NRR and NMSS staff at all levels
 - Interim Guidance to be used to supplement office procedures (COM-101 and P&P 5-1) until they are updated

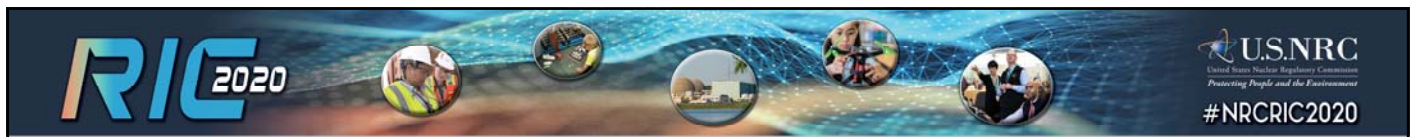


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Changes

- Guidance on coordination between offices
- Guidance on public outreach responsibilities
- Discussion of Site-Specific information/status such as
 - site conditions, i.e., groundwater contamination,
 - significant contamination,
 - status of spent fuel transfer to ISFSI, etc.
 - License conditions and amendments and exemption effective dates
 - Licensing Basis information that should not be deleted
- Lessons learned from project management
 - Impacts due to License Transfer concurrent with submittal of early PSDAR(s)
 - Best Practices



Changes (continued)

- Knowledge Transfer Process
 - Guidance on Resources and Schedule of concurrent reviews
 - Guidance on internal staff charges
 - Guidance on when the transition period begins and ends
 - Guidance on enhanced coordination between offices.
 - License transfer during transition lessons learned
 - Resource and Schedule Impacts
 - Communication Plan Implementation
