General Evaluation Criteria*

Criterion 1

Routine and periodic recordkeeping and reporting requirements not used in last 3 years

Criterion 2

Requirements for reports or records that contain <u>information reasonably</u> <u>accessible to the agency from alternative resources</u>

Criterion 3

Requirements for reports or records that could be modified to result in reduced burden without impacting programmatic needs, regulatory efficiency, or transparency, through—

- less frequent reporting,
- shortened record retention periods,
- requiring entities to maintain a record rather than submit a repot, or
- implementing another mechanism that reduces burden for collecting or retaining information

Criterion 4

Recordkeeping and reporting requirements that result in significant burden









Additional Considerations

Reports or records that contain information used by other Federal agencies, State and local governments, or federally recognized Tribes will be dropped from the review if the information collected is necessary to support the NRC's mission or to fulfill a binding NRC obligation.

These criteria are not intended to be mutually exclusive, and a given regulation may satisfy one or more criteria.
