SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS THE ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING PROCESS FOR THE FORT CALHOUN STATION, UNIT NO. 1 LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION

On Tuesday, June 18, 2002, members of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held public environmental scoping meetings in Omaha, Nebraska, in support of the staff's review of the Fort Calhoun Station, Unit No. 1 (Ft. Calhoun) license renewal application. Two sessions were held to allow maximum public participation. Formal presentations were made by John Tappert, William Burton, and Thomas Kenyon of the NRC. Enclosures 1 and 1A are the corrected transcripts (with a copy of the slides, Enclosure 4) recorded at both meetings. Enclosure 2 is the agenda for both meetings. Enclosure 3 is a List of Attendees for both the 1:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. sessions.

The purpose of the meetings was to provide the public an opportunity to participate in the environmental scoping process by providing comments on any issues the public thought the NRC staff should consider while preparing a plant-specific supplement to NUREG-1437, "Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal of Nuclear Power Plants," for Ft. Calhoun. The staff presentations outlined the overall license renewal process; provided a description of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) review process; discussed the environmental requirements outlined in 10 CFR Part 51; and addressed how these requirements would be implemented during the Ft. Calhoun license renewal review.

After the formal presentations, given by the NRC staff, officials from Omaha Public Power District were given the opportunity to address the audience and provide brief presentations which focused on the environmental report that was submitted as part of the license renewal application. Members of the public were also invited to provide comments. Approximately 80 people attended the two sessions, with 21 people making comments. Attendees included representatives of the NRC, Omaha Public Power District, the nuclear industry, State agencies, the press, and members of the public.
