SUBJECT: MIDCYCLE PERFORMANCE REVIEW AND INSPECTION PLAN –
CALLAWAY PLANT

Dear Mr. Heflin:

On August 4, 2009, the NRC staff completed its performance review of Callaway Plant for the first half of the calendar year 2009 assessment cycle. Our technical staff reviewed performance indicators for the most recent quarter and inspection results over the previous 12 months. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance during this period and our plans for future inspections at your facility.

This performance review and enclosed inspection plan do not include security information. A separate letter designated and marked as "Official Use Only – Security-Information" will include the security cornerstone review and resultant inspection plan.

Plant performance for the most recent quarter at Callaway Plant was within the Licensee Response column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on all inspection findings being classified as having very low safety significance (Green) and all performance indicators indicating performance at a level requiring no additional NRC oversight (Green). Therefore, we plan to conduct reactor oversight process baseline inspections at your facility.

The staff identified that there were four Green findings for the current 12-month assessment period with documented crosscutting aspects in the human performance area. There is a crosscutting theme associated with these findings that involves the failure to communicate or use human error prevention techniques, for example, prejob briefs [H.4 (a)]. In evaluating your scope of efforts and progress in addressing this crosscutting theme, the staff determined that you appropriately recognized this crosscutting theme and took actions to address it. The corrective actions which have been implemented are judged, at this time, to be effective in mitigating this crosscutting theme. We will continue to monitor the effectiveness of your corrective actions during the next assessment period.


The enclosed inspection plan details the inspections, less those related to physical protection scheduled through December 31, 2010. The inspection plan is provided to allow for the resolution of any scheduling conflicts and personnel availability issues well in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature. The inspections in the last nine months of the inspection plan are tentative and may be revised at the end-of-cycle review. We are also evaluating potential changes to the

inspection program in the radiation safety cornerstone. Consequently, some specific inspection procedures and the inspection schedule may be revised for 2010.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
