Dear Mr. Reddemann:

Our review of Point Beach Unit 2 identified that you have crossed the threshold from Green to White for the Unplanned Scrams per 7000 Critical Hours performance indicator for the second quarter of 2001. Therefore, we plan to conduct a supplemental inspection to better understand the causes contributing to your decline in performance.

This letter is to inform you that we are planning a supplemental inspection at your facility during the week of October 29, 2001, to review your root cause(s), contributing cause(s), and extent of condition evaluation, as well as any corrective actions that you identified. This inspection will be conducted in accordance with Inspection Procedure 95001.
