DECISION ITEM: SECY-98-117  
TITLE: SHELWELL SERVICES, INC., RISK ASSESSMENT

The Commission (with all Commissioners agreeing) disapproved the staff's recommendation to seek the State's agreement and proceed with license termination. The Commission approved the use of probabilistic approaches in determining whether the site could be released for unrestricted use. The Commission's decision is recorded in the Staff Requirements Memorandum (SRM) of June 30, 1998.

COMMENT RESOLUTION

In their vote sheets, all Commissioners disapproved the staff's recommendation to pursue Option 2.
