Alternate Fracture Toughness Requirements for Protection Against Pressurized Thermal Shock Events: Final Rule; Correction, 10 CFR Part 50 (RIN 3150-AI01, NRC-2007-0008)

On February 3, 2010, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (75 FR 5495) correcting the January 4, 2010, final rule (75 FR 13) that amended its regulations to provide alternate fracture toughness requirements for protection against pressurized thermal shock events for pressurized water reactor pressure vessels. This document corrects errors that occurred in paragraph (g) formulas when the document was formatted for printing in the *Federal Register*. The rule correction is effective February 3, 2010, the date on which the original final rule became effective.
