Revision of Fee Schedules; Fee Recovery for Fiscal Year 2014: Final Rule; 10 CFR Parts 170 and 171 (RIN 3150-AJ32; NRC-2013-0276)

On June 30, 2014, the NRC published a final rule in the *Federal Register* ([79 FR 37124](#)) effective August 29, 2014, amending the licensing, inspection, and annual fees charged to its applicants and licensees. These amendments are necessary to implement the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990, as amended, which requires the NRC to recover, through fees, approximately 90 percent of its budget authority in fiscal year 2014, not including amounts appropriated for Waste Incidental to Reprocessing, amounts appropriated for generic homeland security activities, and Inspector General services for the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board. These fees represent the cost of the NRC's services provided to applicants and licensees.

Public Meeting with Omaha Public Power District

On June 24, 2014, the staff and representatives from Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) held a publicly noticed telephone call to discuss the license amendment request for Fort Calhoun Station, Unit 1, regarding OPPD's proposed revision to the technical specification for operability of electrical power systems during shutdown.

Publication of Revision 2 to Regulatory Guide (RG) 8.22, “Bioassay at Uranium Mills”

The NRC issued Revision 2 of RG 8.22, “Bioassay at Uranium Mills.” This guide describes a method that the NRC staff considers acceptable for bioassay programs at uranium mills during uranium recovery operations and applicable portions of uranium conversion facilities where there is a possibility of exposure to the dust of uranium compounds. Revision 2 provides better alignment of staff guidance with: (1) 10 CFR Part 20; (2) the internal dose assessment recommended methods by the International Commission on Radiological Protection (ICRP) Publication 30, “Limits for Intakes of Radionuclides by Workers”; and (3) the recommended bioassay interpretation method by ICRP Publication 54, “Individual Monitoring for Intakes of Radionuclides by Workers: Design and Interpretation.” The RG is publicly available in ADAMS at Accession No. ML13350A638 and was announced in the *Federal Register* on June 20, 2014 (79 FR 35387).
