

- The Pokagon Band of the Potawatomi Tribe is served by Indiana Michigan Power Company







# Cook Comments on NRC Policy and Protocol Manual



- The Manual should include the Pokagon Band as having Trust Lands within a 50-mile radius of a nuclear power plant.
- The Policy should foster outreach to all Tribal communities (recognized or not) on all issues of interest, with formal consultation of recognized Tribes focused on those with significant impacts.



## **Licensing Actions Are Not Suitable for Tribal Consult**

- Licensing Actions addressed in 10 CFR Part 2
  - Those regulations provide for public participation, including by Tribal Governments
  - Scope of Tribal consult should be only on associated activities like environmental or historic site reviews
- Commission role for those Tribal consultations not called for by a statute.





## Respecting Tribal Sovereignty Is a Two-way Street

- Tribal sovereignty deserves respect, whether the Tribe is supporting a nuclear project, opposing it, or has the matter under advisement.
- Ohngo Gaudadeh Devia v. NRC, Nos. 05-1419, 05-1420, 06-1087 (D.C. Cir.)
  - The language in the NRC annual summary of litigation could be more precise
    - "dissident Goshutes"
    - "PFS is still awaiting"
