**I. SECY-00-0169 - Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corp. & AMERGEN Vermont, LLC (Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station), Docket No. 50-271-LT; Citizens Awareness Network's ("CAN") Motion to Stay the Effectiveness of NRC Staff's July 7th Order Approving License Transfer**

The Commission<sup>(1)</sup> approved a Memorandum and Order which (1) denies CAN's motion to stay the effectiveness of the NRC staff's order approving the license transfer, (2) denies CAN's request for an investigation, and (3) grants CAN's motion for clarification.

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1. Section 201 of the Energy Reorganization Act, 42 U.S.C.
