**I. SECY-00-0232 - Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (Gore, Oklahoma Site Decommissioning) Docket No. 40-8027-MLA-4**

The Commission<sup>(1)</sup> approved a Memorandum and Order affirming the Presiding Officer's ruling that Oklahoma has standing and has stated its concerns with sufficient particularity, and declining to hear the remainder of Sequoyah's appeal.

SECY-01-0001 - Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit 3; Facility Operating License NPF-49) Petition for Review of Licensing Board's Order, Adopting Agreed License Condition, Denying Request for Evidentiary Hearing on Other Issues and Terminating Proceeding (LBP-00-26, Issued Oct. 26, 2000); Supplement to SECY-00-0223**

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order which denies in part and grants in part the petition for review of LBP-00-26 filed by intervenors, Connecticut Coalition Against Millstone and the Long Island Coalition Against Millstone, and invites the filing of amicus curiae briefs.
