## I. SECY-01-0153 - International Uranium (USA) Corp. White Mesa Uranium Mill Review of LBP-01-15

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to an appeal of LBP-01-15 in which the Presiding Officer denied Petitioner Glen Canyon Group of the Sierra Club's hearing request for lack of standing. The Memorandum and Order affirms LBP-01-15.

II. SECY-01-0180 - Private Fuel Storage (Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation) Docket No. 72-22-ISFSI; Review of LBP-01-19, 53 NRC 416 (May 31, 2001)

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to CLI-01-15 in which the Commission accepted review of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel's referred ruling on the threshold probability for a design basis air crash event at an independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI). The Memorandum and Order affirms the Board's ruling in

LBP-01-19 that the threshold probability for design basis events should be set at one in a million  $(1 \times 10^{-6})$  for ISFSIs.

III. SECY-01-0181 - U.S. Enrichment Corporation; Pace's Petition for Review of Director's Decision on the Paducah Upgrade Amendment
