## I. SECY-02-0129 - Pacific Gas & Electric Co. (Diablo Canyon Power Plant, Units 1 and 2); Multiple Petitions to Intervene

The Commission<sup>(1)</sup> approved a Memorandum and Order related to the Pacific Gas & Electric Co. (PG&E) application to transfer its licenses for the Diablo Canyon Power Plant, Units 1 and 2, to a newly established generating company. The Memorandum and Order requests the petitioners and the applicant to file briefs addressing the question of whether the Commission has statutory authority to retain or impose antitrust conditions for commercial nuclear power plants licensed under Section 104b. of the Atomic Energy Act.
