**I. SECY-04-0066 - DOMINION NUCLEAR CONNECTICUT (MILLSTONE NUCLEAR POWER STATION, UNITS 2 AND 3)
(REJECTION BY THE SECRETARY OF PETITION TO INTERVENE IN LICENSE RENEWAL PROCEEDING AS
PREMATURE)**

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to the Connecticut Coalition Against Millstone's (CCAM) request that the Commission vacate the Secretary's rejection of the CCAM petition to intervene in the Millstone license renewal proceeding as premature. The Order denied CCAM's request because CCAM had filed its petition before the NRC staff had published its Notice of Opportunity for Hearing.
