The Commission was briefed by the NRC staff and a panel of stakeholders on the status of actions taken in response to lessons learned from the Fukushima Dai-ichi accident. The panel of stakeholders included James Scarola, Executive Director of the U.S. Industry Fukushima Response; David Heacock, President and Chief Nuclear Officer, Dominion; David Lochbaum, Director of the Nuclear Safety Project at the Union of Concerned Scientists; and Paul Smith, Nuclear Systems Analysis Section Chief, Illinois Emergency Management Agency.

The staff should keep the Commission informed of any resource challenges it encounters in completing the development of the new ground motion characterization model, "Next Generation Attenuation Relationships for Central & Eastern North America (NGA-East)," by its scheduled 2015 date.
