CHAIRMAN DIAZ: Good morning. Madam Secretary.

MS. VIETTI-COOK: This is on Private Fuel Storage (Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation). The Commission is being asked to act on the State of Utah's petition for discretionary Commission review of the Licensing Board's April 25, 2005 unpublished Memorandum and Order. The Board had approved many of Private Fuel Storage's proposed redactions of passages in the Board's prior "financial assurance" and "decommissioning funding assurance" decisions and also many of Private Fuel Storage's proposed redactions of associated documents in the administrative record.

The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order which denies Utah's petition and affirms the Board's Order except insofar as it pertains to the five instances specified by Private Fuel Storage where the information is already in the public domain.
