Dear Mr. Orszag:

As required by Section 752 of the Financial Services and General Government Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2009, Public Law 111-8, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) hereby reports the total size of its workforce.

As of December 31, 2008, NRC employed 4181 civilian workers and 0 military workers.

With regard to contract workers, our best estimate is 3500, which includes the following kinds of support: information technology, security, facility/building maintenance, guard service, health services, telecom, secretarial support, day care, training support, and technical support to a variety of line programs.

The total number of civilian (NRC employees), military, and the estimated contract workers as of December 31, 2008, is 7681. It should be noted that many contract workers and some employees are employed less than full time.
