Dear Mr. Chairman:

As required by Section 8302 of Title 41 of the United States Code, I am submitting the fiscal year (FY) 2011 Buy American Act Report for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), as follows:

1. During FY 2011, the NRC purchased articles, materials, and supplies manufactured outside the United States in the amount of \$133,002.88.
2. The NRC purchased items in the amount of \$4,459.00 pursuant to the waiver enunciated at FAR 25.402(a)(1) permitting waiver of the Buy American Act for products or services that are less than \$203,000 under the World Trade Organization Government Procurement Agreement.
3. The NRC purchased items in the amount of \$128,543.88 in accordance with the exception provided at FAR 25.103(e) allowing for the acquisition of a foreign end product without regard to the restriction of the Buy American Act for information technology that is a commercial item.
4. Procurement funds expended on articles, materials, and supplies manufactured inside the United States totaled \$11,897,082.41 for FY 2011.
5. Procurement funds expended outside the United States totaled \$133,002.88 for FY 2011.

The NRC looks forward to continuing its support of the Buy American program.
