On behalf of the Commission, I am responding to your letter of May 21, 2012, regarding the status of the staff's submittal on SECY-12-0062 to the Commission requesting authorization to issue Pilgrim's renewed license. The following answers are provided in response to your letter.

1. Have you voted on SECY-12-0062?

The Commission has voted on SECY-12-0062 as follows:
