COMPENSATORY MEASURES FOR MAINE YANKEE ATOMIC POWER
COMPANY (EA-02-077)

Dear Mr. Meisner:

On May 23, 2002, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued an Order for Interim Safeguards and Security Compensatory Measures for Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company (MYAPC). This Order applied to decommissioning nuclear power plants with spent fuel in the spent fuel pool. By correspondence dated February 27, 2004, you have reported that all fuel has been removed from the spent fuel pool and requested that the Order be rescinded. Accordingly, as provided in Section III of the Order, I hereby terminate the Order. MYAPC shall continue to adhere to the terms of the Order for Interim Safeguards and Security Compensatory Measures for Maine Yankee Atomic Power Station dated October 16, 2002, for your independent spent fuel storage installation, as well as other terms and conditions of the MYAPC license and the Commission's regulations. As a consequence of this action, MYAPC is no longer authorized to use the spent fuel pool to store spent fuel.
