IATA-11-04 – "Information on Attacking Nuclear Power Plants Found in Alleged Manifesto For Situational Awareness"

The NRC issued IATA-11-04 on August 25, 2011, to all NRC affected licensees: Power reactors; Decommissioning Reactors; Non-power Reactors; Fuel Fabrication, Enrichment and Conversion/Deconversion Facilities; and Independent Spent Fuel Installations. It was also provided to all Agreement State and Non-Agreement State Radiation Control Program Directors and State Liaison Officers for dissemination to their licensees as appropriate.

These licensees were provided an update on the current threat environment and requested to maintain alertness to security-related matters.
