On July 21, 2016, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Information Notice (IN) 2016-10, "Identification and Protection of Unattended Openings and Underground Pathways That Intersect a Security Boundary". The IN was addressed to all Operating Power Reactors, including those under construction; Early Site Permits, combined license under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 52; Decommissioning Reactors, including those that are permanently defueled but have not transitioned to decommissioning; Specific Source Material licensed under 10 CFR Part 40; Fuel Fabrication and Enrichment Facilities licensed under 10 CFR Part 70; Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation licensees, and of certificates of compliance under 10 CFR Part 72. The IN contains physical security information and is designated as "Official Use Only – Security-Related Information." Therefore, the referenced document is being withheld from public disclosure in accordance with NRC Sensitive Unclassified Non-Safeguards Information handling requirements.
