SA-05-05, "National Special Security Event For The Presidential State Of The Union Address In The Washington, DC, Area" dated January 28, 2005

In 2005, the NRC released a security advisory which recommended that each NRC power reactor licensee consider implementing certain security measures. In lieu of the Presidential State of the Union Address (January 31 - February 3, 2005), licensees were asked to review the need for and maintain certain security measures and to avoid receiving or shipping radioactive materials as stated in SA-04-01

The NRC continued to monitor threat-related reporting and other relevant developments, and planned to coordinate its assessment activities with other Federal and State agencies for any indication of a threat to licensees.

The Nuclear regulatory commission (NRC) has issued SA-05-05 to affected operating power reactor licensees. Note that the security advisory contains physical security information and is, therefore, being withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390.
