The following Security Advisory (SA) is not available because it is marked "Official Use Only – Security-Related Information/Safeguards Information" and is exempted from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390.

SA-05-06, "FRAUDULENT USE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS" DATED MARCH 16, 2005

This advisory was provided to assist facility managers and other security personnel responsible for protecting NRC-licensed facilities. An incident occurred in which individuals were found to be using false social security numbers to obtain work at a nuclear power plant. This event underscored the need for personnel security controls at all levels. The advisory had urged licensees to ensure a heightened level of awareness and to scrutinize the validity of the information disclosed by a visitor when a social security number was presented.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has issued SA-05-06- to operating power reactor licensees, category 1 fuel cycle facilities, independent spent fuel storage installations, uranium conversion facilities, gaseous diffusion plants. Note that the security advisory contains physical security information and is, therefore, being withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390.
