NRC Schedules Conference on Spent Nuclear Fuel Management

An NRC conference on spent nuclear fuel management topics will be held Sept. 17-18 in King of Prussia, Pa. The conference will be open to the public.

More than 200 participants are expected to attend the gathering, which will take place at the Crowne Plaza Philadelphia Hotel, 260 Mall Blvd. The conference will run from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Sept. 17, and from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Sept. 18. On Sept. 16, the NRC will also hold an open house for attendees from 6-8 p.m. in the lobby of the NRC Region I Office, 2100 Renaissance Blvd., King of Prussia.

The NRC Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards' Division of Spent Fuel Management is organizing the conference. It is the division's annual engagement with the public and industry to share the latest developments in the area of spent nuclear fuel and to hear from stakeholders regarding the future of spent fuel management.

Topics will include spent fuel licensing, aging management, extended storage and transportation, stakeholder perspectives, inspections, and operating experiences.
