NRC Schedules Community Meeting in Erwin to Discuss Inspection and Oversight of Fuel Facilities

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has scheduled a public meeting for July 16 in Erwin, Tenn., to discuss its inspection and oversight of fuel facilities.

The meeting is scheduled to begin at 7 p.m. at the Erwin Town Hall, 211 North Main Ave.

Following a short introductory NRC presentation, the meeting will be opened to attendees, who each will be given five minutes to make statements and/or ask questions of the NRC staff involved in licensing and inspection activities. In May, the NRC held an open house in Erwin to discuss the agency's review of Nuclear Fuel Service's safety performance during the two-year period ending Dec. 31, 2018. The licensee performance review found no program areas needing improvement and determined that the Erwinbased facility continued to operate safely, meeting NRC requirements for the protection of nearby residents and the environment.

To accommodate those who had requested a more conventional format, the NRC staff planned the July 16 meeting to enable attendees to provide comments and/or ask questions.
