NRC Announces Opportunity to Request Hearing on SHINE Medical Technologies' Operating License Application

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has [accepted for review](#) SHINE Medical Technologies' application for a license to operate the company's proposed Medical Isotope Production Facility in Janesville, Wis. SHINE submitted the operating license application on July 17.

The NRC has published in the *Federal Register* a [notice of opportunity](#) to intervene in an adjudicatory hearing regarding the application. Petitions must be filed by March 10, 2020, by anyone whose interest may be affected by the proposed license and who wishes to participate as a party in the proceeding. More information on the [hearing process](#) and the [application](#), absent proprietary details, are available on the NRC website.

Accepting the application for review, or "docketing" the application, does not indicate whether the Commission will approve or reject the request.
