NRC Names New Senior Resident Inspector at the Wolf Creek Nuclear Power Plant



The NRC has selected Christopher Henderson as the new senior resident inspector at the Wolf Creek nuclear power plant in Burlington, Kan.

Henderson joined the NRC in 2010 as a reactor operations engineer. He was the senior resident inspector at Arkansas Nuclear One in Russellville, Ark., and the resident inspector at the Cooper Nuclear Station in Brownsville, Neb. He served in the U.S. Navy as a nuclear-trained submarine warfare officer and holds a master's degree and bachelor's degree in nuclear engineering from Kansas State University.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear power plant site has at least two NRC resident inspectors. Henderson joins resident inspector John Vera. They serve as the agency's eyes and ears at the facility, conducting inspections, monitoring significant work projects, and interacting with plant workers and the public.
