NRC Accepts Application for Subsequent License Renewal of North Anna Reactors

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has <u>accepted</u> for review an application from Virginia Electric and Power Company (Dominion) to renew for 20 years the previously renewed operating licenses of North Anna Power Station Units 1 and 2, located near Louisa, Va. Dominion submitted its application to the NRC on Aug. 24.

The <u>application</u>, without proprietary details, is available on the NRC website. Dominion is seeking a license renewal for the North Anna units, located approximately 40 miles northwest of Richmond, Va. The NRC approved the initial license renewal in March 2003, with Unit 1 currently licensed to operate through April 1, 2038, and Unit 2 through Aug. 21, 2040.

Accepting the application for review, or "docketing" it, does not indicate whether the Commission will approve or reject the request. More information about <u>subsequent license renewal</u> is available on the NRC website.

The NRC has published in the *Federal Register* a <u>notice of opportunity</u> to intervene in an adjudicatory hearing. Petitions to intervene in a hearing must be filed by Dec. 14, 2020, by anyone whose interest may be affected by the proposed license renewal and who wishes to participate as a party in the proceeding.
